

Parish Council Meeting held on 19th April 1938.

Present. Messrs F.B. Leigh, W.C. Lillywhite, G. White, H. Knott, G. Mills

Election of Chairman. It was proposed Mr White seconded Mr Mills & carried unanimously that Mr F.B. Leigh be elected Chairman for the ensuing year.

The Chair. Mr Leigh then went into the Chair.

Election of Vice-Chairman. It was proposed Mr Leigh seconded Mr Knott & carried unanimously that Mr W.C. Lillywhite be elected Vice-Chairman.

Minutes. The Minutes of the previous meeting were read & confirmed.

Bus Services. A letter was read from the Canterbury City Council re the extension of the City bus services to Strangers Lane.

Telephone Kiosk. It was agreed that a letter be sent to the A.R.P. Officer, Bridge-Blean R.D.C. asking if it were possible to obtain any assistance for the maintenance of a Telephone Kiosk at New House Road under the A.R.P. scheme.

Lighting. It was agreed that a letter be sent to the Kent Electric Power Co. asking if their terms for street lighting were reasonable.

A.R.P. Store. It was agreed that the A.R.P. Officer be asked to arrange for a store for respirators in the parish.

Rights of Way. Mr Lillywhite reported that all Rights of Way were now in hand.

Drains. It was reported that the drain at the top of Longford Lane

was used for throwing away washing water which formed a pool at the outlet by Mr. Mills house. It was agreed that a letter be sent to the Sanitary Inspector Bridge Plain R.D.C. re this matter,

Roads/Highways

It was agreed that a letter be sent to the Surveyor Kent County Council calling his attention to the dangerous kerb at the entrance to Howfield & the need for a 30 mile limit on the offroad road up to Reed Cottage, or alternatively a foot path on the South side of the Road.
