Highways It was agreed that the Rural District Highways Surveyor be asked to erect signs for New House & Effen Roads and Bonford Lane.

Bus Service

It was agreed that further letters be sent to the East Kent Road Car Co. re the extension of the City Bus Service + also to the A.R.P. Officer Bridge Plain Rural District Council.

It was reported that the train at Tonford Lane was now satisfactory.

30 mile limit

It was reported that the 30 mile per hour speed limit on the Stoford Road had been extended up to St Antony's

Harris Charity

It was proposed by Mr White, seconded Mr Hawkins + agreed unanimously that Mr W. E. Lillywhite be elected Parish ~~Local~~ Representative Trustee to the Harris Trust.

School Children

It was reported that school children in the Parish had to walk or to pay bus fares to get to their schools, in some cases as far as St Dunstan's. It was agreed that letters be sent to the Kent Education Committee + the Canterbury City Education Committee re this.
