- STREET LIGHTING. The Clerk reported no further progress and was instructed to enquire of Seaboard the present position as to completion of the work. Reported that the Insurance of the standards in Grays Way had been effected.

- RIGHTS OF WAY A letter dated 19 March from City Council stated they had been
