

- CHAIRMAN Cllor Mr. A.R. Palmer in the Chair.
- PRESENT Cllors Mr. A.R. Palmer, Mr. S.V. Jacobs, Mr. W.J. Knott, Mr. R.E. Tolputt, Mr. A.B. Richardson and Mrs V.C. Sanders.
- ABSENCE Apology for absence received from Cllor Mr. W.E. Bradshaw.
- MINUTES The Minutes of the previous Meeting were confirmed and signed by the Chairman.
- HIGHWAYS Reported that a new plate had not yet been erected. Clerk Street Name Plate. to write again to City Engineer to ask when the Strangers Ln. plate would be installed.
- GRAVEL EXCAVATION. A letter of 30 Octr was received from K.C.C. Secretarys BRETT'S. Dept. consequent upon the Public Meeting held at C'bury on 17 Octr 1975 the effect of which was that the K.C.C. Sub-Committee approved the workings in principle but would not issue a final decision until other reports on access and agreement as to Bretts existing workings were considered. Also the Sec. of State for Environment would have to give a decision regarding a departure from the Development Plan.
- The Chairman called attention to the Legal Public Notice appearing in the local Press of 14 Novr in connection with the departure from the Kent Development Plan and that representations against the grant of permission should be submitted to County Plan. Officer, Kirbys Lane, C'bury by 5th Dec 1975.
- Cllor Mr. Jacobs moved that the Council should lodge objections following closely the grounds already submitted to C'by District Council and other authorities. Seconded by Cllor Mr. Tolputt and unanimously agreed. Clerk instructed to attend to this matter.
- ACCOUNTS. Cllor Mr. Richardson proposed that the following account be passed for payment:-

Seconded by Cllor Mr. Knott and unanimously agreed.
- HIGHWAYS A.2 Canterbury ByPass.  
Rights of Way. Letter of 6 Novr from K.C.C. showing plan of proposals for this Bypass as it affected public rights of way was produced and examined and notice received of informal meeting at C'by City Council offices on Monday 15 Dec at 10.30 a.m. with view of getting observations. Decided that the only public footpath in this parish that the route affected was where it would cross Public F.P. 491 (known as the Elevated F.P.) adjacent to Hollow Lane. The Chairman said he would attend the meeting.
- HIGHWAYS Members of the Council raised the question of the possibility of a speed limit being now imposed in these roads as street lighting had been installed. Clerk to make the necessary application to the K.C.C. Highways & Transportation Dept.

**PUBLIC HEALTH** Cllor Mrs Sanders queried the practice of the District Waste disposal Council in the collection of household refuse in Bramley Avenue on consecutive days twice in a week, namely the old City area on one day and the old Bridge Blean area on another day in the same road. The Chairman explained that this was due to an incentive scheme of the old Bridge Blean area which was still operative but the City Council were looking into the matter and ultimately it would be altered.

**STREET LIGHTING.** Cllor Mrs Sanders raised the question of providing street lights in Bramley Avenue. Matter discussed and considered that probably 2 lamps in Bramley Avenue and probably 2 in Ashenden Close would be required. Mambers to investigate and report back to the next meeting.

**FOOTPATHS - PROHIBITION OF HORSE RIDING.** The Chairman reported that From junction this matter raised by this Council in January last Merton Ln/ had now been settled by the City Council in that at a Iffin Ln Meeting of the Amenities Cttee on 21 Oct it was recommended that the City Council make a Byelaw under Sec 236, L.G.Act 1972 prohibiting the riding of horses on the footpaths in question. This was approved by the Council at its meeting on 12 Novr.

**PLANNING APPLICATIONS.** Two lists of Applications were received but none concerned this parish.
