

MINUTES of Parish Council Meeting held at 123, Ashford Road, Thanington, Kent, on Friday 13th February 1976

CHAIRMAN. Cllor Mr. A.R.Palmer in the Chair.

PRESENT Cllors Messrs A.R.Palmer, S.V.Jacobs, W.E.Bradshaw, W.J.Knott R.E.Tolputt and A.B.Richardson.

MINUTES The Minutes of the previous Meeting were confirmed & signed.

GRAVEL EXTRACTION. A letter of 30 Jan from Dept of Environment stated Bretts. it had been decided the responsibility for deciding the application to extract gravel should be left to the local planning authority.

STREET LIGHTING. The Clerk reported that the Street Lighting Agreement signed by Seeboard had been received, but estimates for lights in Bramley Avenue and Ashenden Close had not yet been received.

HIGHWAYS. Letter of 3rd Feb from City Engineer stated an inspection Hollow Lane regarding mud from banks in Hollow Lane would be made and work carried out when labour available. Larkey Valley As regards cars parked in Hollow Lane near junction of Wincheap and Litter in Larkey Valley Wood on car park these would receive attention

RIGHTS OF WAY. Card from City Engineer stated this matter would receive FP 464 attention.

BW 469 Cllor Mr. Jacobs reported that this bridle way was obstructed at the point where the bridleway leaves Larkey Valley Woods. The obstruction comprised poles about 15 feet in length placed horizontally across the right of way and supported by a fence stake in the centre. The Clerk said he had inspected and confirmed the obstruction. Clerk instructed to write to the City Engineer to have the obstruction removed.

K.A.P.C. Circular 83 dated 6th February was read and discussed

MUSIC & DANCING LICENCES. Notice was received that the City Council proposed to resolve that appropriate licences should be obtained for premises where public dancing, singing, music or other public entertainment is performed.

KENT STRUCTURE PLAN. Notice was received from the City Council of a public participation meeting on Thursday 25 March at 7.30 pm at 41, Old Dover Road, to which a Member of the Parish Council was invited. Cllor Mr. Bradshaw said that if possible he would attend the meeting.

PLANNING APPLICATIONS. Planning Applications were received and discussed.
