

MINUTES OF THE PARISH COUNCIL MEETING held at the Ashford Road Social Club House, Ashford Road, Thanington Without, on Monday, 13th November, 1978 at 8 pm.

MINUTES OF THE PREVIOUS MEETING were confirmed and signed.

LIGHT BY THE TELEPHONE KIOSK at junction of Hollow Lane/New House Lane.

Councillor Mr. K. McMillan reported that Seeboard had all the necessary equipment ready, it was hoped that the job would be completed shortly.

PARISH COUNCIL NOTICE BOARD: The Chairman, Councillor Mr. A. R. Palmer, reported that it was not necessary to obtain planning permission to erect the Parish Council Notice Board at the top of Grays Way. It was suggested that it be placed between the two trees, and Councillors Mr. S. V. Jacobs and Mrs. M. Kite kindly agreed to look at the proposed site and confirm that it was a satisfactory position. Mr. E. Janman to be asked to make the board.

OVERGROWN HEDGE etc. 84 Ashford Rd. It was noted that Mrs. Eastwood had had the willow tree felled, thus clearing any obstruction to the entry to Tonford Lane.

Payments: It was proposed by Councillors Mr. W. Knott, seconded by Mrs. Kite and carried, that the Seeboard energy charge of £31.70 be paid.

CORRESPONDENCE: The Chairman, Councillor Mr. A. R. Palmer passed round a letter of appreciation which he had received from Mr. & Mrs. Burch, of Bramley Avenue, for the flowers and ~~card-re~~ congratulations received on the occasion of their Diamond Wedding anniversary.

PLANNING APPLICATIONS:

74 New House Lane. Erection of garage and workshop and extension to bungalow. No objections.

70 New House Lane. Erection of one dwelling. No objections.

170 Ashford Rd. No planning permission necessary for extension, but in any case, no objections raised.

Wystaria Cottage, Iffen Lane. Erection of one bungalow.

Councillors Mr. W. Knott and Mr. K. McMillan to look at this and let the Clerk know of there were any objections to raise.

CORRESPONDENCE: Canterbury City Council. Notice of meeting re dog training. It was agreed that the poster should be displayed on the notice board Department of Transport. Notice to vary new road at Stuppington Lane Noted.

Canterbury City Council: Programme of work on footpaths and bridleways. The Councillors asked to take note of any work considered necessary and to report to the next meeting.

ANY OTHER BUSINESS: Mr. K. McMillan queried the spending of the money allocated for lighting programme. It was agreed that this should be left until the light at the junction of Hollow Lane/New House Lane was operating. When it was time to give consideration to lighting New House Lane, the Chairman suggested that a special Parish Meeting be called and for the matter to be discussed and a vote taken.

The Clerk was asked to look out the list of objectors to the New House Close lighting programme, which had been collected by Mr. Lee.
