

MINUTES OF THE PARISH COUNCIL MEETING held at Ashford Road Social Club House, Ashford Road, Thanington Without on Monday, 13th April, 1981 at 8 pm.

MINUTES OF THE PREVIOUS MEETING were confirmed and signed.

MATTERS ARISING ON MINUTES:

POTHOLES IN ROADS: Copies of correspondence between the Clerk and City Engineer and Direct Labour Organisation dated 9th Dec. 1980 to 10th March, 1981 produced to members relative to Stuppington Lane, Merton Lane, Hollow Lane, Tonford Lane, Ashford Road, together with report that the Clerk had received a telephone message from the authorities that the roads were being surveyed with a view to repairs being done.

PAYMENT OF ACCOUNTS: Proposed by Councillor Mr. W. Knott seconded by Councillor Mr. C. Day that the issue of the cheque for £1.50 payable to Dorset Assoc. of Parish Councils for the order of an Advice Booklet for Parish Councils be confirmed. Resolution agreed. Proposed by Councillor Mr. W. Knott, seconded by Councillor Mrs. M. Kite and agreed that the Seaboard account for £1 variation of maintenance charges for Jan. Feb and March 1981 be passed for payment.

CORRESPONDENCE:

STREET LIGHTING: Letter dated 16th March 1981 from Seaboard received, the effect of which was that maintenance charges as from 1st April 1981 had been increased by 13% and that any variation of labour charges would affect future costs of maintenance. Noted.

K.C.C. ELECTIONS: Notification received from City Council of the County Council Elections on 7th May 1981. Notice received from City Cll. had been posted on the Parish Council Notice board.

PARISH COUNCIL ACCOUNTS: The Annual Accounts in the Council's Receipts and Payments Book made up to 31st March, 1981 produced to members for inspection. Proposed by Councillor Miss S. Knott, seconded by Councillor Mr. C. Day and agreed that the Chairman should sign the book as required.

HARRIS CHARITY: The accounts made up and checked to 5th February 1981 produced to members. Proposed by Councillor Mrs. M. Kite, seconded by Councillor Miss S. Kott that the accounts be agreed and produced to the Annual Assembly of the Parish Meeting on 27th April 1981. Resolution agreed.

39 Grays Way: Copy of Planning permission received relating to extension and alterations.

GRAVEL EXTRACTION: Milton Manor and Hambrook Marshes. Revised working Scheme with plans received from County Planning Dept, and inspected by members, Proposed by Councillor Mr. W. Knott, seconded by Councillor Mrs.M. Kite and agreed that the action of the Council in informing the K.C.C. that the members had no comments be confirmed.
