

MINUTES OF THE PARISH COUNCIL MEETING held at the Ashford Road Social Club House, Ashford Road, Thanington Without, on Monday Tuesday, 6th April 1982 at 8 pm.

MINUTES OF THE PREVIOUS MEETING confirmed and signed.

MATTERS ARISING:

BUS SHELTER: As this had not yet been installed, a reminder to be sent.

BUS TIME TABLE: Not yet installed as the bus shelter has not been installed.

STILE NEW HOUSELANE: Reply received from Kent County Council that this comes under Canterbury City Council and a copy of our letter sent to them.

KENT COUNTY COUNCIL: Governing Bodies, County Primary Schools. As nothing further has been heard, another letter to be written.

MEETING RE NUCLEAR WEAPONS AND SAFETY: Councillors Mr. W. Knott and Miss S. Knott had attended.

PAYMENT OF ACCOUNTS: There were no accounts to be presented.

CORRESPONDENCE:

K.A.P.C. CIRCULAR No. 103.

HEAVY LORRIES: Discussion took place and it was agreed that a letter be written to the Secretary of State for Transport opposing the increase in weight of lorries from 32.5 tonnes to 40 tonnes.

PRECEPT PROCEDURE: Noted.

AREA COMMITTEE REPORT: Noted.

KENT COUNTY COUNCIL: Stour Valley amended plan to be on public deposit from 16th ~~May~~ to April to 28th May. Noted.

ANNUAL PARISH MEETING: Wednesday, 12th May, 1982, at St. Faith's Hall, New House Lane at 8 pm.

ANNUAL PARISH ACCOUNTS: Studied and signed.

HARRIS CHARITY ACCOUNTS: in the hands of the auditor and will be presented at the May meeting of the Parish Council.

PLANNING APPLICATIONS:

Land adjoining 76 New House Lane; application for siting of temporary mobile home and development of land to small holding.

Councillors Mr. W. Knott and Mr. E. Kite had visited the site and considered that the proposed development to a small holding would improve the site, and neighbours were apparently not against it.

A condition should be imposed that not more than one mobile home should be allowed on the site and that this should be occupied by the applicant and his immediate family or by such person or persons authorised by the applicant to carry on the business. Also that ordinary towing caravans should not be permitted on the site.

A letter to this effect to be sent to the City Architect & Planner.

13 Ash enden Close: Extension to front of dwelling. Councillors Mr. C. Day and Mr. E. Kite had visited the site. It was considered that this application was unusual and the extension would come in front of the building line. A reply to be sent to the City Architect & Planner to this effect and adding that the Parish Council did not care for the plan.

Previous applications: Erection of one dwelling on a land at Grays Way. Granted. Thanington Court Farm: change of use to manufacture of frozen products. Formally withdrawn.

ANY OTHER BUSINESS: Councillor Mr. W. Knott had been asked whether the land at the corner of Grays Way / Ashford Road could be cleared up. A request to be made to the City Engineer that the rubbish be cleared away and asking for the dip to be filled in and levelled.

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ANY OTHER BUSINESS: Cont:

Councillor Mr. C. Day reported that the stile from Milton Manor to the footpath by the river had been vandalised. A letter to be written to Mr. Brett asking for this to be repaired.

Councillor Mr. C. Day also reported an overhanging branch opposite the lay-by in Ashford Road. A letter to be sent to the City Engineer asking for this to be dealt with.
