

MINUTES OF THE PARISH COUNCIL MEETING held at the Ashford Road Social Club House, Ashford Road, Thanington Without, on Monday, 11th October, 1982 at 8 pm.

MATTERS ARISING:

BUS SHELTER: Councillor Mr. E. Kite noted that the bus time table had not yet been fixed on the shelter. A letter to be written asking for this to be done.

K.C.C. Governing Bodies, County Primary Schools. Nothing to report.

FOOTPATH 490: This had not yet been attended to.

BANKS BY BRIDGE IN HOLLOW LANE: A reply received that the Canterbury City Council are getting in touch with the contractors, Brian Colquhoun and Partners regarding this. The erosion being caused by removal of trees and vegetation during the Canterbury by-pass construction work.

KENT COUNTY COUNCIL: Mineral Plan. Report received for information.

PAYMENT OF ACCOUNT: There were none.

CORRESPONDENCE:

K.C.C. Gipsy Problem. It was noted that the ratepayers would have to pay £10,000 per site for two caravans. After discussion it was agreed that the Canterbury City Council, who already had one permanent site and another in the pipeline, were doing all they could.

K.A.P.C. Bulletin 108. Item 2. Stonewall cladding. It was noted that some houses in Wincheap had this, but the Parish Council felt nothing could be done.

Previous applications: Erection of bungalow, land partly adjoining 29 and to rear of 31-34 Ashenden Close. Application refused.

Councillor Miss S. Knott reported that some drainage work had been done in the Merton Lane/Stuppington Lane area, but the conditions at Merton Lane/Stuppington Lane corner were still extremely bad. Agreed another letter be written.

Lower Bridge Street/Burgate pedestrian crossing. Councillor Miss S. Knott reported that yet another accident had occurred at this crossing, and asked that the Parish Council press the Canterbury City Council to make this a Pelican Crossing. Agreed that a letter be sent to Councillor Mr. B. A. Porter, in whose Ward the crossing is sited, asking him to press for urgent attention to be given.
