ROAD SAFETY IN WINCHEAP: Reply received from Canterbury City Council as follows:³/₄

'The criteria for the provision of a pedestrian crossing requires that a pedestrian and vehicle count be taken over a 16 hour period. The four peak hours out of the 16 hour period are then applied to the formula:- Pedestrians X vehicles² must equal or exceed 10₀. The

criteria for the provision of a Pelican crossing is greater than this.

This reply was noted, but Councillors were unable to understand it.
