FILLING OF VACANCY BY CO-OPTION: The Chairman explained the position regarding the requirement for any vacancy by co-option to be filled by 35 days after an election. In this case the final date would be June 25th. The Chairman explained that several attempts had been made in vain. When she was appraised of the situation, Mrs. McMillan had agreed to be co-opted.

It was proposed by Cllr. Page, seconded by Cllr. Goddard and unanimously agreed that Mrs. J. McMillan be co-opted as a Parish Councillor to represent South Ward.

Mrs. McMillan read aloud and signed the form of Acceptance of Office. The Chairman then thanked her and welcomed her back onto the Council.
