- 1) **APPROVAL OF THE MINUTES OF THE LAST MEETING:** The Minutes of the February Meeting were unanimously approved and duly signed by the Chairman
  
- 2) **COUNCIL**
  - a) Declaration of any member's interest in agenda items – *None*

  - c) Co-option of Councillor. The council unanimously agreed to co-opt Chi Chi Uwadi
  - d) Accounts preview. The Clerk gave a copy of this years account, He stated that although the year-end was end of March it would give councillors the chance to look at the accounts prior to year-end. The Chairman thanked the Clerk for his swift work on the PC accounts.

  - a) The Clerk confirmed that payments approved at the February meeting had been dispatched.
  - b) The Clerk confirmed that planning applications were returned.
    - i) CA/03/01742/THA – 19 Bramley Avenue – Recommended Acceptance
  - c) 6 Bins are on order – price agreed on labels at £5 per bin, Delivery expected in next two weeks
  - d) Top of Grays Way on Canterbury side pavement is scheduled for repair.
  - e) Resurfacing of Ashford Road CCC say joints are to their standard. PC not happy that job has been correctly done. The clerk was instructed to give reminder again.
  - f) Flishers, Clerk had meeting on Wednesday with Tony Trotter CCC enforcement, Tony to write to Flishers.
  - g) Tonford Lane sign, not replaced as yet – *Email sent asking CCC to confirm they have the sign, no answer*
  - h) Bus Shelter in Strangers Lane, CCC have agreed to fit new one after April no date as yet.
  - i) Car in River Stour – *CCC Environment and Streetscene say they cannot do anything about it but has reported the matter to The Environment Agency.* The clerk was instructed to give reminder again.
  - j) Pavement outside St Nicolas Church and top of Grays Way, Kerbs being dropped to allow wheel char and prams to pass. – *Highways have carried out site survey and are going to get back to clerk with report on how this can be done.*
  - k) 30 MPH signs in roadways were wearing away. Reported but no date can be given as to when this repair can be carried out. The clerk was instructed to give reminder again.
  - l) Footpath sign needed at Hollow Lane, Iffin Lane & New House Lane Junction, Waiting the cost for having name on them.
  - m) Clerk rang 01622 221563 If we provide bags and or skip they will do work. Work now in second week on Raised footpath. The PC agreed that they should purchase a gas ring, gas bottle and Kettle for Kent Environment Task Force. Proposed by Chairman and Seconded by Terry Maple.
  - n) Hollow Lane Junction to have clean up – This will happen on Monday 15<sup>th</sup> March.
  - o) Pothole reported by Cllr PB, reported to highways put on 2 hour repair. These had had their repair and Highways asked that we do not waste their time. Proper checks should be carried out.
