- 1. APPROVAL OF THE MINUTES OF THE LAST MEETING:** The Minutes of the September Meeting were unanimously approved and duly signed by the Chairman.

It was agreed to use AJ for work at Strangers Lane and around New House Lane. The £30 we now pay G&C Services would cease and would in future be paid to AJ.
