LARKEY VALLEY Wood, a hundred acres of 'special scientific value' that straddles Chartham and Thanington Without could be made more public-friendly as a result of a joint venture between the two parishes.

The woods, owned and managed by Canterbury City Council, are looked after by a team of volunteers under the guidance of honorary warden, Glen Sharman.

Mr Sharman, who monitors the population of dormice in the woods, one of the largest in the country, attended a meeting set up by Thanington Without Parish Council between Chartham and TWPC to discuss possible improvements to Larkey Valley Wood (LVW).

LVW is entitled to receive monies from the Woodland Grant Scheme, although so far no area has been
