Parish councillors who attended the meeting on February 8 at ARCA hall – Veronica Litten, Ann Dawes, Paul Hornibrook (CPC) and Pam Blackman and Terry Davis (TWPC) – put forward the following ideas for further discussion:

**Open areas with seating formed from logs.**

Trail posts that could be colour-coded and give directional information.

**Promotion of the woods.**

Public Right of Ways clearly indicated.

**Signage to show specific trees/plants in the area.**

A leaflet to indicate walks and areas of special interest.

**Tours of the woods, such as in spring when the bluebells and primroses are out.**
