KCC TOLD: WE NEED PROMISED £16,000 POSTBUS SUBSIDY

KCC cabinet member Keith Ferrin is being asked to commit to spending the same subsidy for a rural transport service that he had pledged to spend on the Postbus service before it was axed.

Thanington Without south ward is one of 23 rural locations left either without any form of public transport or a sub-standard service since the withdrawal of the Postbus service in September.

The County Council had previously spent £12,000 on subsidising the Postbus but had offered to increase this to £16,000 to try to save the Royal Mail service.
