DIVERSION of RIGHT OF WAY

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that :-

At a Parish Meeting for the Parish of Thanington Without, held on the 27th day of May, 1926, the following Resolution was passed :-

“That the Meeting in pursuance of the Public Health Act, 1875, and the Local Government Act, 1894, do consent to the proposed Diversion of a Highway or Footpath now running from Hollow Lane, past New House Farm, and on to the Parish of Petham, as shown on the Ordnance Map.

“It is proposed to divert that part of the Path as shown in black on the Plan, at the point marked “A” near Hollow Lane, continuing for about 980 feet to that Point marked “B” and hence for about 1285 feet to that Point marked “C” on the original Path.

From the Point marked “C” the Paths to continue as at present.”

And it was further Resolved that a Meeting of the Parish be held on the 12th day of AUGUST, 1926, at 7 o'clock, to confirm or otherwise the above Resolution.
