- d) Iffin Lane/Merton Lane Big lumps are missing from the middle of the Road, Tree root in Road, Road markings are faded to the point where they can no longer be seen, no give way sign on junction-On KH list, waiting for better weather-contact from KCC, work order has been issued- ½ completed (road markings) -re report tree root-re-reported tree root as its own issue
